Accepted Abstracts will be assigned to a Session Chair, who will invite the author to submit a full paper, including expected slides to be presented.

Abstract font is Times New Roman and the font point size is 10, consistent with the paper preparation. The assigned Session Chair will serve as the primary reviewer of submitted papers and the presentation slides to be used at the conference. **Please provide an updated abstract using the above abstract preparation guide information, separate, but included with your paper submission for use in the Conference general program handout.**
